REGIONAL REGULATION OF NGANJUK REGENCY NUMBER 9 OF 2024 ABOUT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SHOPPING CENTERS AND SUPERMARKET STORES		
ABSTRACT	-	<p>a. that Shopping Centers and Supermarkets are trading facilities that can increase regional economic growth in order to encourage the creation of community welfare.</p> <p>b. that in order to optimize the function of Shopping Centers and Supermarkets in the Regions as a means of Trade, it is necessary to develop, empower and improve the quality of management and development, arrangement and coaching which provides more opportunities, support and development of the people's economy which includes cooperatives and micro, small and medium enterprises.</p> <p>c. that Nganjuk Regency Regional Regulation Number 7 of 2019 concerning the Implementation of Shopping Centers and Supermarkets needs to be adjusted to developments in laws and regulations and the legal needs of the community.</p> <p>d. that based on the considerations as referred to in letters a, b and c, it is necessary to stipulate Regional Regulations concerning the Implementation of Shopping Centers and Supermarkets</p>
	-	The legal basis for this regulation is Article 18 Paragraph (6) of the 1945 Constitution of the Republic of Indonesia; Law Number 12 of 1950; Law Number 12 of 2011; Law Number 7 of 2014; Law Number 23 of 2014; Government Regulation Number 5 of 2021; Government Regulation Number 29 of 2021; Regulation of the Minister of Home Affairs Number 80 of 2015; Regulation of the Minister of Trade Number 21 of 2021; Regulation of the Minister of Trade Number 23 of 2021; Regional Regulation of Nganjuk Regency Number 2 of 2021
	-	This Regent Regulation regulates the types of Shopping Centers and Supermarkets; establishment of Shopping Centers and Supermarkets; management and sales systems for Goods; Partnerships and business responsibilities; development of business cooperation and cooperation agreements; operating hours; licensing; stabilization of Basic Necessities and/or Important Goods; reconstruction of Shopping Centers; and guidance and supervision.
